Parenting Tip of the Month

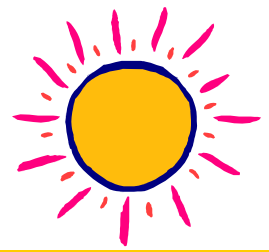

Programs for Birth to 6 years

Age Specific Programs (No Brothers & Sisters)

Together Time

A program for parents and caregivers with children birth - 6 years. The program will provide the opportunity to socialize and learn in an early learning environment. Children are free to rotate between activities throughout the room.

Messy Play

Includes hands-on activities, with more emphasis on fine motor development, and tactile use (involves touch).

Creative Play

Parent/Child Drop-In provided by our partner agency, Agincourt Community Services Association.

Free Play

In our playroom, we provide an environment where children are able to learn through play.

Dad and Me

A program for men with children that may include sand & water play, craft, circle time, table activities and guest facilitators.

Family Time

An Interactive program similar to Together Time which may include siblings over 6 years.

Wings of Discovery (3 – 6 years)

Science based program for young children. This program will cover eight projects such as, trip to my home, trip to my community, trip to the garden, trip around the world, trip with transportation, trip to the grocery store, trip under the surface and trip back in time.

*Computer Program (3 - 4 years)

Children will have the opportunity to learn basic computer skills through educational games, with the help of their parents and the program facilitator.

Fun with Numbers (2 - 6 years)

Children will start to recognize numbers by participating in different hands-on activities which may include number puzzles, counting toys, counting beads and flashcards.

Bookmaking (2 - 6 years)

The Bookmaking workshop is a hands on learning opportunity for parents and children. During the workshop, parents and children will create books together, as well as, sing songs and listen to stories.

Read and Rhyme (2 - 6 years)

This program promotes early literacy through books, songs, finger plays, poems and nursery rhymes. Try to remember your favorites to share with the group.

*Living and Learning with Baby (6 weeks to 6 months)

Come and meet other parents and talk about, adjusting to parenthood, infant nutrition, growth, development and keeping your child safe. Provided by Public Health. Limited spaces.

School Readiness Programs

(No Brothers & Sisters)

* Readiness to Learn

A program for children who will attend Junior Kindergarten in September 2010. The outcome of the program is to help the child develop the skills they will need to succeed in a school setting. This is a pre-registered program.

*Creative Learning (C.L.I.P)

(For children entering SK in September 2010)

This program will focus on school readiness. This is a pre-registered program.
