Programs

Focus on teaching children about themselves, family and pets.

Providing children with unique physical activities including parachute fun, bean bag toss, and other physical activities.

Families have the opportunity to socialize while children develop new language such as Cantonese & Mandarin..

Children will learn about occupations: Firefighters, Bus Drivers, Police Officers, and Librarians in an interactive environment.

Helping children in Kindergarten strengthen their reading and math skills.

A program for dads and male role models to bond with children through play and fun activities.

An interactive drop-in program which includes siblings over 6 years.

An excellent introductory program to introduce children to simple French words.

Starting to recognize letters by participating in different hands-on activities: -alphabet blocks, puzzles, stamps and storybooks.

Participating in different hands-on activities which may include number puzzles, counting toys, counting beads and flashcards.

To promote the development of healthy eating habits in young children. Children will have the opportunity to help make a healthy snack that they will enjoy at snack time

The families will be encouraged to massage their babies during the demonstration by using canola or olive oil.

Includes hands-on activities, with more emphasis on fine motor development, and tactile use (involves touch).

An interactive program where children and parents will explore various types of music and musical instruments.

Providing preschoolers with key learning skills they need to succeed in a school setting: independent, listening and social skills.

An engaging program where children ages 0 to 6 discover science through fun experiments and hands-on activities.

Focusing on storytelling in a group setting. A variety of stories are read in the program, including large picture books, and stories involving props (such as puppets).

Focusing on toddler's development through play. Parents and caregivers will engage in activities with their child.
